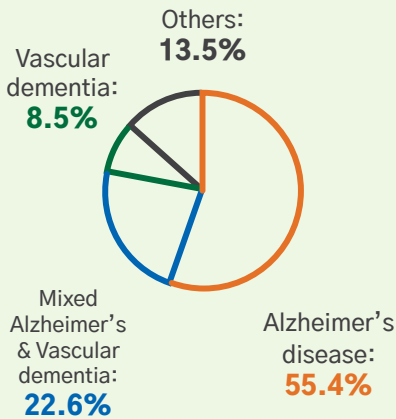

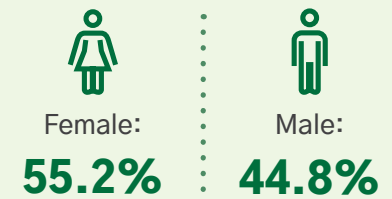

MCI: **27.0 (24.5, 28.5)**

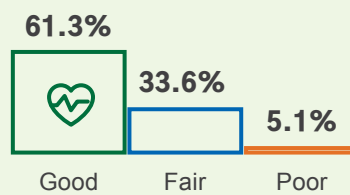

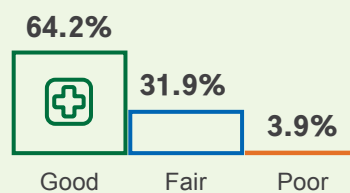
